

5 Messages Highlighting High Severity

These emphasize the serious consequences of PFAS exposure:

1. Long-term exposure to high levels of PFAS has been linked to cancer, liver damage, and immune system dysfunction.
2. Exposure to high levels of PFAS during pregnancy has been associated with complications and adverse birth outcomes.
3. Even small amounts of PFAS can build up over time and lead to serious health consequences.
4. PFAS-related illnesses can take years to develop, making early prevention critical.
5. The severity of PFAS health impacts makes it essential to take protective action now.



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
